Please respond as soon as possible as the deadline for payment is near. We want to enable everyone who needs a ride to have the opportunity to attend.



Tiffany's Seton Hall was knocked out in the first round by Duquesne, and Taylor's Syracuse University and Bianca's U. of South Carolina went head to head in the Sweet Sixteen, with Syracuse pulling off the upset of #1 ranked SC!
